Azure Plans and Subscriptions

Azure services are sold as Plans and Subscriptions that include a legal and payment agreement as well as administrative boundaries. All Azure resources are provisioned in the <u>Azure Management portal</u>. If applicable, a member of our Professional Services team may assist with setting up your Azure environment. Billing and Pricing

Microsoft charges for Azure on a consumption basis, meaning subscribers receive a bill each month that only charges them for the specific resources and services they have used.

In the AppDirect Marketplace, click <u>Manage Bills</u> to view your invoices or update your payment methods.
